

## GETTING HERE

### West Bound

From the A169 Whitby to Pickering Road after leaving Sleights and ascending Blue Bank travelling for approximately two miles west wards take the second turn on your left sign posted Goathland. Follow the road as it descends downwards the village will be seen in front of you and below taking care as you enter the village over a narrow one-way bridge which spans the North York's Moors Railway Line, Goathland Station is to your right and below you. Follow the road as it swings left and climbs a small rise, to your right will be The Inn on the Moor and Goathland Garage, to your left will be the Goathland Hotel. Immediately past the hotel and located at its side there is a cattle grid, turn left and cross over, follow the metalled road for approximately 400 metres. The entrance to the Hub is located on your left through two farm, five-barred gates.

### East Bound

Take the A169 Pickering to Whitby Road travelling approximately 13 miles, as you pass RAF Fylingdales on your right the road descends with a hair pin bend at the bottom and a small bridge known as Ellerbeck. Climb the hill and in approximately 500 metres take the road sign posted Goathland to your left, follow the road into the village and at the mini roundabout turn right, The Mallyan Spout Hotel is set back across the Common in front of you, on your right is St. Marys.

Follow the road into the village, the War Memorial will be on your left as the road swings right with West Mount Tea Rooms, the Village Shops and Post Office set back across the common to your right. Proceed forwards passing the Car Park on your left and T Junction sign posted Beckhole. Travel forwards and in approximately 200 metres turn right across the cattle grid located at the side of the Goathland Hotel which will be to your right. Travel approximately 400 metres, the entrance to the Hub is on your left through two five barred gates.

**CAUTION** there is a low bridge on this route, if your vehicle is higher than 11 feet six inches please continue some three miles to the next turn located on you left also sign posted Goathland and follow the route ascribed for West Bound traffic.
